EDUCATION SYSTEM

USJ adopts the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). This is an international and flexible system that facilitates the student's choice regarding the number of credits, while respecting a maximum and minimum number of credits per semester. At USJ, one year of study (two semesters) is equivalent to 60 credits (ECTS) per year for a full-time program. The student obtains a diploma when they validate the required number of credits:

- Undergraduate programs (Bachelor): 180 to 240 credits.
- Graduate programs (Master): 90 to 120 credits.
- Postgraduate program (PhD): 180 credits.

These credits are fully capitalizable. This means that the student can **accumulate and transfer credits validated at USJ** to any other university or institution that adopts the same ECTS system in order to carry out an exchange semester, to pursue their program or to start a new program.
