



# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER'S PROGRAMS (2<sup>nd</sup> CYCLE)

Admission to a master's program at USJ is generally based on **two criteria**:

- Your academic qualifications
- The institution you are applying to

**Note:** USJ welcomes all students regardless of nationality, religion, and geographical background.

## General and Mandatory Requirements

### Requirement 1: Holding a Baccalaureate

Applicants **must hold the Lebanese Baccalaureate or an equivalent diploma recognized** by the Equivalence Commission at the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education, qualifying them for admission to the institution concerned.

### Requirement 2: Holding the Necessary Academic Degree

Typically, a bachelor's degree is required for admission to a master's program. Depending on the program, this requirement may be accompanied by an interview, a review of the applicant's file, or an exam.

The academic degree held is subject to an equivalency review, with the USJ Equivalence Commission responsible for assessment and final decision.

## Specific Admission Requirements

Certain USJ programs have specific admission requirements, which may include:

- A French placement test
- A review of the applicant's file
- An interview

In some cases, all three are required.
