



DIPLOMA EQUIVALENCIES FOR THE 2nd AND 3rd CYCLES

USJ Equivalence Commission

An Equivalence Commission is formed at USJ, in accordance with Article 74 of the University's Bylaws. Its members include the Rector of the University or, in his absence, the Acting Rector (Chairman), and the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs.

This Commission determines:

- The recognition of university degrees obtained abroad, or academic years of study completed abroad for students wanting to continue their education at USJ;
- Recognition by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education of university degrees obtained from another Lebanese university, or academic years of study completed at another Lebanese university for students wanting to continue their education at USJ.
- The courses attended at a faculty or institution affiliated to USJ are taken into consideration for students wishing to continue their studies at a different USJ faculty or institution.

The Equivalence Commission can take one of four decisions:

- Favorable decision
- Favorable decision subject to conditions
- Application rejected
- Application to be reviewed
