The PhD in Geography – Environment and Spatial Planning aims to train researchers and future university instructors in the fields of environmental studies and sustainable development, enhancing their scientific, technical, and methodological expertise. They will contribute to the production of new knowledge and the development of innovative methodological approaches adapted to the Lebanese context. Candidates will also address environmental issues across multiple dimensions including natural and anthropogenic factors, as well as the interactions between humans and their environments.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES FOR THE PHD IN GEOGRAPHY - TOURISM AND CULTURAL MANAGEMENT

The PhD in Geography – Tourism and Cultural Management aims to train researchers and future university instructors capable of advancing knowledge and developing concepts in the fields of tourism geography and heritage enhancement.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES FOR THE PHDS IN SOCIOLOGY, ANTHROPOLOGY, AND INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION

The PhDs in Sociology, Anthropology, and Information and Communication consist of writing a PhD thesis, an original study based on experimental research, supported by theoretical knowledge relevant to the candidate's chosen field.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES FOR THE PHD IN LEADERSHIP AND HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

The PhD in Leadership and Human Resources Management is specifically designed for candidates committed to advancing research in leadership and human resources management.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prerequisites:

- Art Criticism and Curatorial Studies: Hold a Master in a discipline related to art.
- History International Relations: Hold a Master in History, Political Science, or International Relations.

- Geography Environment and Spatial Planning: Hold a Master degree or any degree deemed equivalent in geography, sciences (physics, chemistry, and biology), engineering (agriculture, surveying, etc.), or any of the social sciences.
- Geography Tourism and Cultural Planning: Hold a Master degree or any degree deemed equivalent in geography, tourism, humanities, or social sciences.
- Sociology: Hold a Master in Humanities.
- Anthropology: Hold a Master in Humanities.
- Information and Communication: Hold a Master in Humanities or in Information and Communication.
- Leadership and Human Resources Management: Hold a Master in Humanities or in Social Sciences.

Achieve a minimum score of 14/20 on the master's thesis

Submit an application file

Attend an oral interview to present and defend the preliminary research proposal if the application file is deemed admissible.
