The aim of this program is to train scientific researchers and advance knowledge of fundamental and applied mathematics in certain cutting-edge fields. The program also aims to apply mathematical knowledge to problem-solving in a variety of fields. The aim of this program is to train candidates in fundamental and applied research in a variety of mathematical fields.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to the PhD program, candidates must hold a bachelor's degree and a master's degree from a university recognized by the Saint Joseph University of Beirut, or equivalent qualifications. The preparation of a dissertation is part of the continuity of the research activities of the Faculty of Science and its research units.

The PhD concludes with the writing and defense of a dissertation. In order to defend their dissertation, PhD candidates must have been registered for six academic semesters during their dissertation. The publication of 2 peer-reviewed scientific articles and participation in recognized international symposia is a prerequisite for defending the dissertation. On average, a dissertation lasts 3 to 4 years.
