

Campus Where the Program is Offered: CSH

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the PhD in Languages program are:

- To train highly qualified researchers in the field of languages and the study of a chosen language or language contact, as well as questions related to language learning/teaching, enabling them to contribute to the advancement and dissemination of research in their field of specialty.
- To train researchers capable of carrying out scientific research in language matters, with disciplinary, methodological, and interdisciplinary skills such as rigor, critical thinking, analytical abilities and innovation.
- To train researchers capable of designing and developing research projects, supervising research teams, promoting and evaluating research work and training researchers, thus demonstrating expertise in disciplinary, methodological, and ethical aspects.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The admission requirements are those set out in the regulations of the Doctoral School of Human and Social Sciences (EDSHS)

1. Registration Procedures

1.1 - PhD registrations take place within the institutions, either in the first or second semester. For the first semester, registrations take place from September 15 to October 15. The deadline can be extended at the request of the dean or director of the institution, until October 30 of the same academic year. For the second semester, they take place between January 15 and February 15.

1.2 – The candidate's application must include:

- An application form (according to the institutions' specifications) with:

- 5 recent passport-sized photos,
- An individual civil status record, or a photocopy of the ID or passport (original or photocopy certified by the competent authority. The same applies to all other documents)
- The Lebanese Baccalaureate or a qualification deemed equivalent (to be submitted to the Equivalence Commission of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon).
- Officially recognized bachelor's degree
- Grade transcript of the bachelor's degree
- The equivalence of any bachelor's degree issued by private Lebanese universities or non-Lebanese universities (to be submitted to the Equivalence Commission of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon. However, holders of a degree from USJ are not required to present this equivalence to continue their studies at their University)
- A master's degree or a title deemed equivalent (to be submitted to the Equivalence Commission of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon. However, holders of a degree from USJ are not required to present this equivalence to continue their studies at their University)
- Grade transcript of the master's degree
- The equivalence of any master's degree or title deemed equivalent issued by private Lebanese universities or non-Lebanese universities (to be submitted to the Equivalence Commission of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon. However, the holders of a degree from USJ are not required to present this equivalence to continue their studies at their University)
- The social security card, otherwise, the forms requested by the USJ administration duly completed and the social security contributions for people entitled to register therein.
- A cover letter, written by the student and addressed to the head of the institution.
- A preliminary thesis proposal, including: the title, definition of the topic, the research question and the hypotheses, a short bibliography, the methodology and research techniques, a tentative thesis outline and the working schedule.

1.3 - Three criteria must be taken into consideration, prior to any admission:

- The student must hold an officially recognized master's degree.
- It is necessary that the discipline of the master's degree and that of the PhD be coherent. Exceptions will be examined by a joint committee composed by mutual agreement between the Director of EDSHS and the head of the institution concerned. The proposals of this committee will, in certain cases, be submitted to the Equivalence Commission of USJ and, where applicable, to the Equivalence Commission of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon.
- The master's degree obtained by the candidate should attest to their competence to carry out research; otherwise, additional training will be required of them, (in accordance with the present point, the Faculty of Languages and Translation requires, in the case of a master's degree defended at a university other than USJ, that the thesis be entrusted, by the head of the PhD program, to an instructor of the discipline to evaluate it and establish a detailed report).

1.4. Study of the application file (before registration):

- The Head of the PhD program studies the file, in consultation, if necessary, with the Director of the Doctoral School; the file is considered admissible, if it meets the following conditions: authenticity of the diplomas, a proof that research training occupies a preponderant place in the candidate's academic itinerary (in particular the master's degree: minimum score of 14/20 required for the master's thesis or the end-of-master project) and compatibility (at least of the master's degree) with the discipline of the PhD program.
- If the file is deemed admissible, the candidate is summoned to an oral interview to present and defend their preliminary research proposal before a committee composed of the Head of the PhD program concerned or their delegate and the Director of the Doctoral School or their delegate; the commission can be expanded by mutual agreement between the Head of the PhD program and the Director of the Doctoral School. Institutions may, if they wish, submit candidates to a written assessment which will be taken into consideration for their acceptance.
- If the Commission gives a favorable opinion on the preliminary thesis proposal, the candidate is admitted and can register; their file is then sent to the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs for final validation.
- After the final validation, registration for the PhD is carried out at the institution and a thesis supervisor is then appointed.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The duration of the program is of 6 semesters minimum and 12 semesters maximum. During this period, the PhD candidate should:

- Submit a detailed thesis project at the end of the second semester of study.
- Attend the disciplinary seminars organized by the FdLT PhD department during the first two semesters of registration.
- Present a research progress report at the start of each academic year before a small committee in the presence of their thesis supervisor. At the end of the presentation, the thesis supervisor signs an authorization to renew the registration.
- Actively participate in activities organized by FdLT or the Doctoral School of Human and Social Sciences (EDSHS): seminars, trainings, conferences, etc. These activities are validated by either FdLT or EDSHS.
- Participate in activities organized by EDSHS as part of the doctoral seminars.
- Publish, before the date of the thesis defense, two articles in indexed peer-reviewed journals (or communications in specialized conferences with a selection committee) relating to their topic.
- Defend their thesis and obtain at least an "Honorable Mention".
