1. PROJECT TITLE

Acquisition of Statistical Analysis Software for Economic Data in Lebanon and the MENA Region.

2. APPLICANT

Faculty of Economics (FSE) at the Saint Joseph University of Beirut (USJ) and Fondation USJ.

3. LOCATION

This project is taking place in Lebanon, at the Faculty of Economics (FSE) on the Innovation and Sports Campus (CIS) of USJ.

4. PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project aligns with the policy of the Faculty of Economics to advance research in the era of artificial intelligence and big data. It aims to equip the Faculty's Center for Economic Research and Documentation (CEDREC) with suitable software tools. These tools will be used for conducting economic and statistical analyses of microeconomic and macroeconomic data from Lebanon and approximately fifteen other countries across the MENA region.

5. OBJECTIVES

Statistical data from Lebanon and MENA countries are frequently subject to partial economic and statistical analysis. The acquisition of these software tools, which include artificial intelligence functionalities, will significantly enhance the statistical analyses conducted by Instructors-Researchers in their teaching and research projects. Likewise, students will benefit in their Master thesis and PhD thesis, where empirical analysis is crucial as it validates or refutes theoretical hypotheses.
