

Satisfaction survey for Instructors-Researchers 2023-2024

As part of its satisfaction surveys, the Office of the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs at Saint Joseph's University Beirut (USJ) has conducted a satisfaction survey among tenured faculty members for the 2023-2024 academic year.

The survey aims to assess the level and reasons for faculty members' satisfaction with USJ and their institution, improve the quality of teaching and student learning, consolidate existing research and services, and increase the sense of belonging to the University.

The survey was administered via the Internet between January 24 and March 27, 2024, to a population of 384 faculty members. 222 responded to the survey.

Giving a response rate of **57.8%**

The tested and validated online questionnaire contained 117 questions, covering faculty member profiles, USJ's mission and governance, institutional management, teaching and learning, research, support and resourcing, working environment and conditions, and general feedback and suggestions.

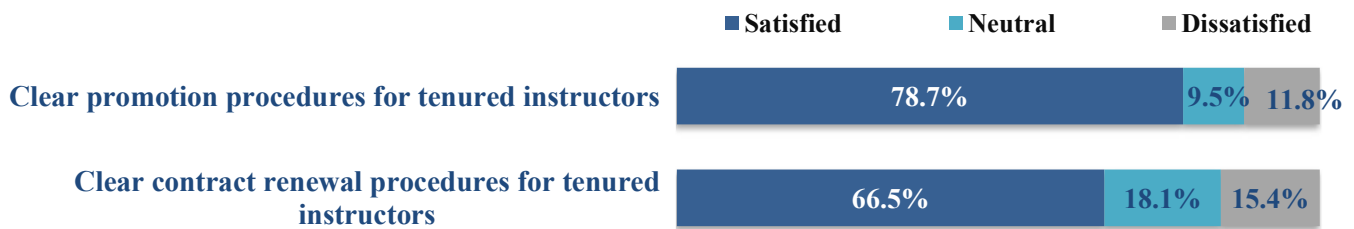

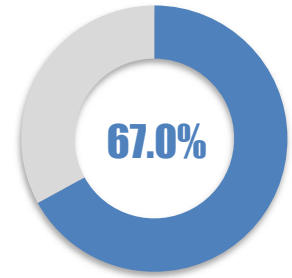

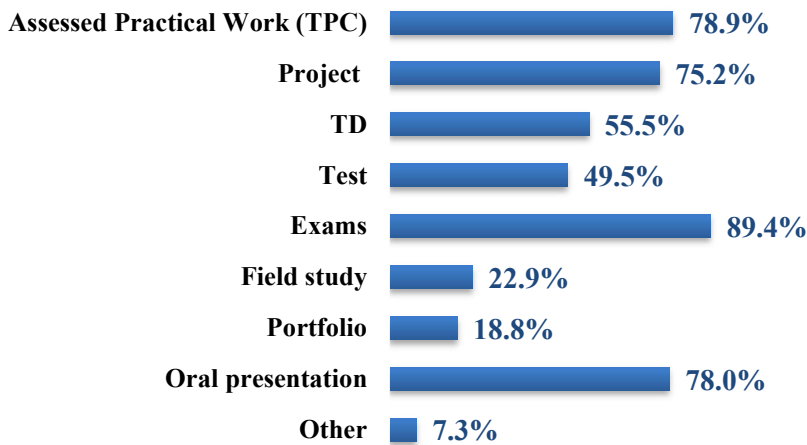

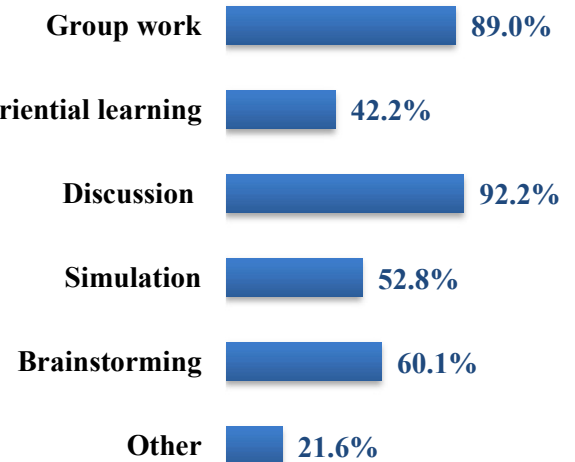

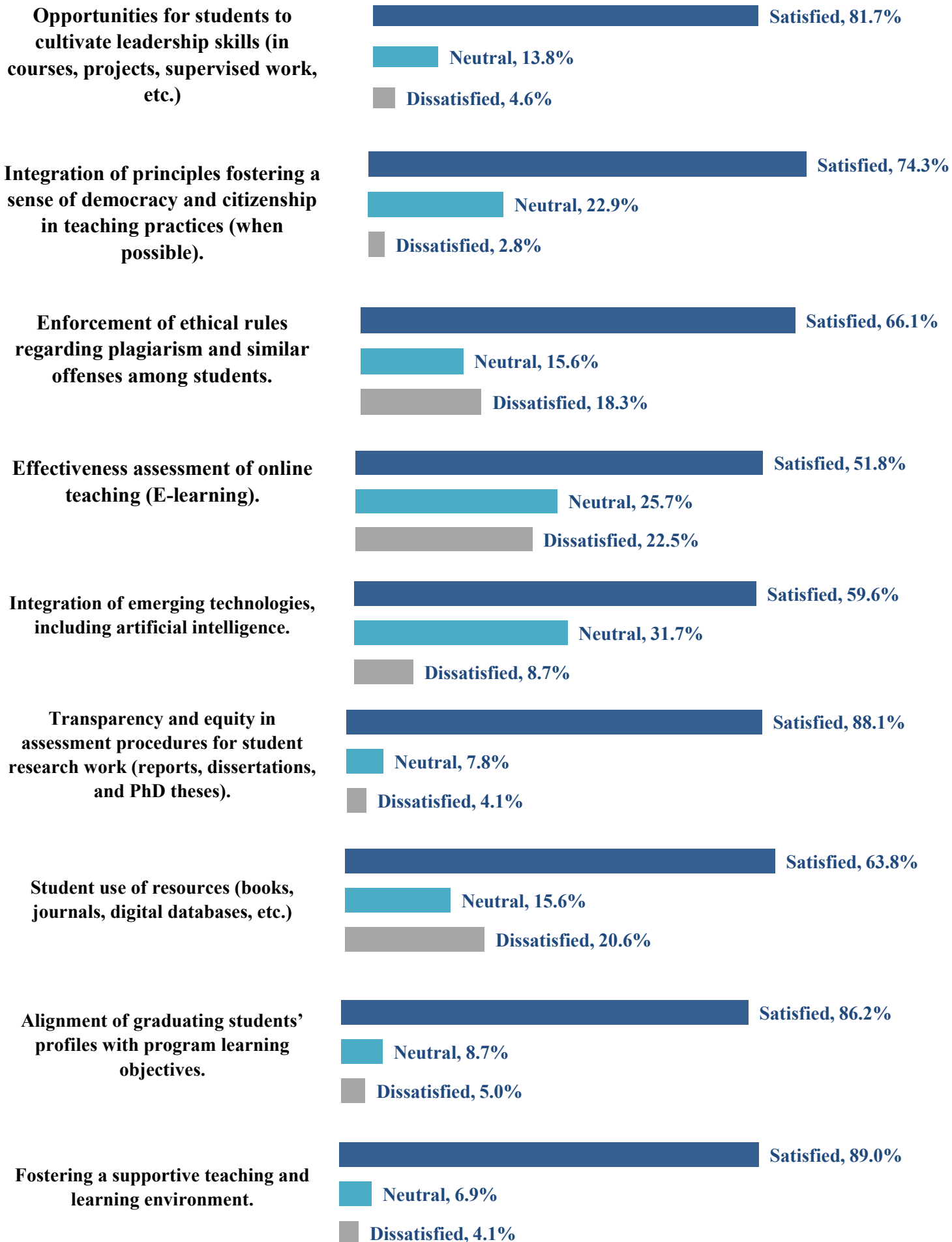

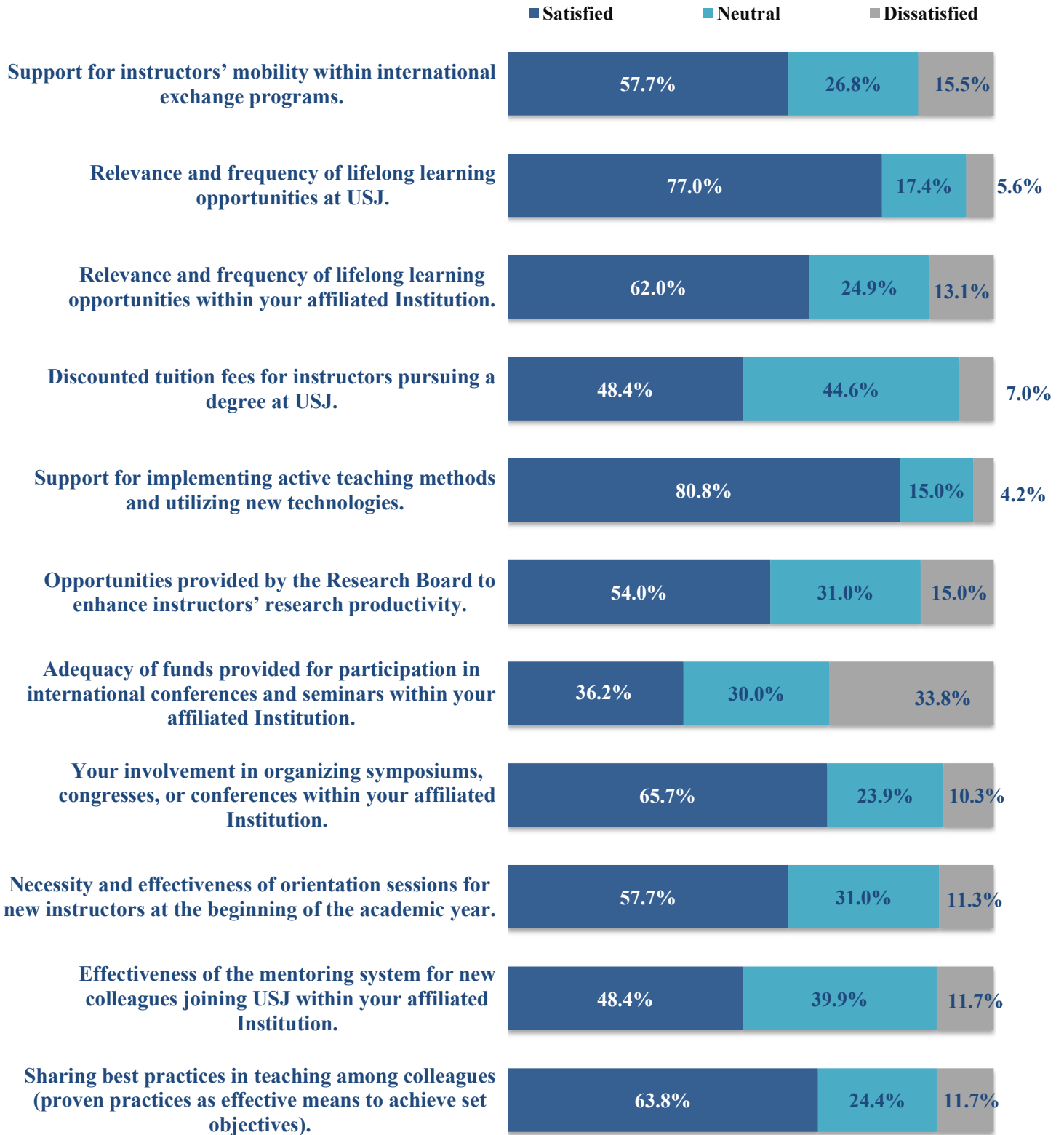

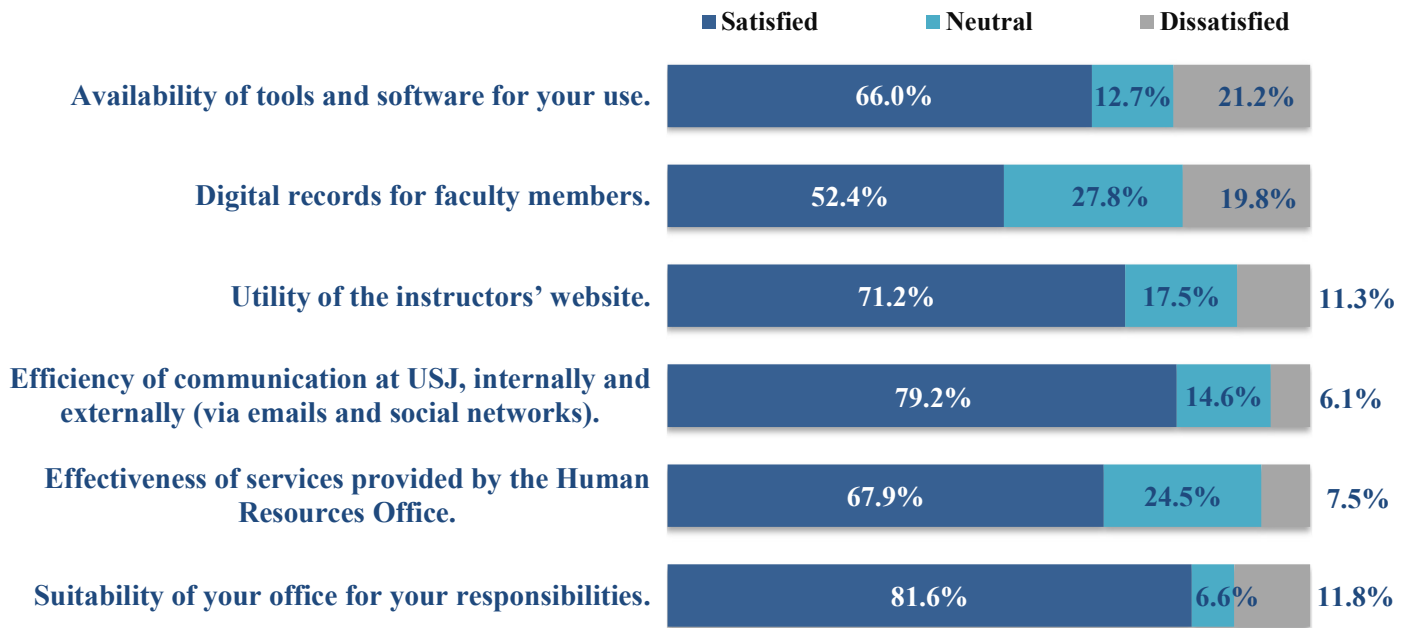
