

Regulations for the Admission of Transfer Students

1. Registration conditions

To be eligible for admission to an Engineering program at the School of Engineering of Beirut (ESIB), a transfer candidate must meet one of the following criteria:

- Hold a scientific bachelor's degree in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Computer Science, Telecommunications, Electronics, Electrotechnics, or an equivalent degree (Bac + 3).
- Have passed one of the entrance exams for French engineering schools (A or B).
- Be enrolled in the Preparatory classes at a French engineering school (A or B).
- Be enrolled in an Engineering program at another institution.

The candidate must not have been a student at ESIB, resigned, dismissed, or eliminated.

2. Registration file

The registration file must include:

- The completed registration form.
- One passport-size photo, dated within the last three months.
- A photocopy of the identity card or a recent individual civil status certificate.
- A certified copy of the Lebanese Baccalaureate or its equivalent.
- Certified copies of obtained degrees.
- Certified copies of grades obtained during university studies.
- A copy of the syllabus of undertaken courses.
- Curriculum Vitae of the candidate.

The candidate is required to submit the original documents on the day of registration for evaluation.

3. Registration fees

The registration fees are determined annually by the ESIB Administration and are non-refundable.

4. Terms and dates

The registration file is to be completed and submitted in person by the candidate to the ESIB Administration in Mar Roukos within the deadlines set by the ESIB Administration.

The file will be examined by the corresponding Head of Department and presented to the Director of ESIB who will compile the list of eligible candidates. Final admission is determined by a jury composed of the Director of ESIB and all Heads of Department, within the limit of the maximum number of seats available. The jury will determine, for each accepted student, the transferred credits, with a total not exceeding 150 ECTS credits.

5. Results

The results of the admission will be communicated to the candidates by the ESIB administration.
