

Regulation for the admission or transfer in Honors and Regular Classes

A list of students, to whom the admission jury has authorized to enroll in the Honors Class is established.

During the first semester, all enrolled students in Honors Class or Regular Class follow courses jointly.

At the end of the first semester, a general ranking of all students is established, based on the student's results.

- Any student authorized to enrolled in the Honors Class (according to the list mentioned above) and who has obtained an average greater than or equal to 14/20 at the end of the first semester must confirm his/her choice to stay in this Class. This confirmation will be submitted in writing to the Department of Preparatory Classes, within three working days after the publication of the results of the first semester. In the absence of confirmation within this time limit, the student will be definitively registered in the Regular Class.

- Any student authorized to enroll in the Honors Class (in accordance with the list mentioned above) and who has obtained an average grade less than 14/20 at the end of first semester is automatically transferred to the Regular Class.

- Any student not authorized to enroll in the Honors Class and having obtained an average grade greater than or equal to 16/20 at the end of the first semester can submit a written request to transfer to the Honors Class. This request will be considered by an ad hoc committee chaired by the Dean. In the case of a approval, the student will be definitively transferred to the Honors Class.

At the end of semester 2, a general ranking of students enrolled in the Honors Class is established, based on the average grade in the Teaching Units during this semester.

- Any student in the Honors Class who has obtained an average grade greater than 15/20 at the end of the second semester but wishing to move to the Regular Class must submit a request. This request will be submitted in writing to the Department of Preparatory Classes, within three working days after the publication of the results of the second semester. It will be considered by an ad hoc committee chaired by the Dean. In the case of approval, the student will be definitively transferred to the Regular Class.

- Any student in the Honors Class who has obtained an average grade less than 13/20 at the end of the second semester is automatically transferred to the Regular Class starting the third academic semester.

- Any student in the Honors Class who has obtained an average grade between 13/20 and 15/20 at the end of the second semester will be advised to switch to the Regular Class.
