REQUIREMENT FOR ACQUIRING THE DIPLOMA

Final project.

MODULES AND ORGANIZATION

Hours: 200 hours including 150 hours of lectures and 50 hours for the final project.

Credits: 20 credits (transferable within the ELFS Master program)

Language of instruction: English.

Presence: remote learning while seminars are required to be attended in person

Frequency of lectures: twice a week, from 5pm till 8pm for online classes.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a. An understanding of the English language.
- b. A Bachelor degree.
- c. A completed six months' professional occupation in humanitarian or development sector, (including internships).

- a. ID (either a copy of the identity card or the passport).
- b. Authenticated copy of the bachelor degree (by the awarding university only).
- c. Curriculum vitae.
- d. Motivation letter.
