till end of May 2025.

REQUIREMENT FOR ACQUIRING THE DIPLOMA

Final project.

MODULES AND ORGANIZATION

Hours: 200 hours including 150 hours of lectures
and 50 hours for the final project.

Credits: 20 credits (transferable within the ELFS
Master program)

Language of instruction: English.

Presence: remote learning while seminars are
required to be attended in person

Frequency of lectures: twice a week, from 5pm till
8pm for online classes.

Bioforce.**

- Analyzing a crisis situation and its multidimensional impact on individuals, society and the State
- Identifying humanitarian issues and challenges of the crisis by describing the humanitarian context, mechanisms and main stakeholders
- Building emergency actions and post-crisis development projects based on solidarity, partnership and international cooperation
- Managing and providing support to teams towards creative and transformative objectives

CANDIDATES

- Master students in social work, political science, human sciences, management, etc., or master students who wish to join this field.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- An understanding of the English language.
- A Bachelor degree.
- A completed six months' professional occupation in humanitarian or development sector, (including internships).

ADMISSION DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- ID (either a copy of the identity card or the passport).
- Authenticated copy of the bachelor degree (by the awarding university only).
- Curriculum vitae.
- Motivation letter.
