Language requirements

The level required is B1. A good level of French is needed in order to work in groups, attend courses and take exams (no certificate required). We strongly recommend that undergraduate incoming Erasmus students have at least a B1 level of French according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).



Visa

Students from the EU do not need to apply for a visa. Students from outside the EU will have to apply for a student visa.

Please note that a tourist visa is not enough to stay in Belgium for periods longer than 3 months.

Disability

Haute École Léonard de Vinci has facilities for students with a learning or physical disability. Disabled students can rely on the support services, which offers material, technical, and social aid

Insurance

If you are a student from an EU member state, or a resident in the EU, Switzerland or the European Economic Space, you should apply for an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in your home country. This will give you access to state-provided healthcare during your stay in Belgium. The card is issued by the healthcare offices in your country.

Please be aware that the EHIC card gives EU citizens access to medical public healthcare during their stay in Belgium, but it is not an alternative to travel insurance. It does cover neither accidents nor any private healthcare or costs such as a return flight home country, lost or stolen property.

Students coming from countries with no healthcare agreement with Belgium should take out private healthcare insurance before coming to Belgium in order to cover medical expenses during the entire period of their stay at Haute Ecole Léonard de Vinci.
