

Walid Ammar MD., Ph.D.

Professor Walid Ammar is currently the Director of the Doctorate and Research in Public Health Program at ISSP. He is also the chair of the Independent Oversight and Advisory Committee (IOAC) at the World Health Organization (WHO).

He served as Director General of the Ministry of Public Health of Lebanon from 1993 till 2020. Under his leadership, reform efforts led to significant improvement in health indicators while decreasing the GDP share of health expenditures.

He has published over 200 per-reviewed papers and book chapters in addition to two books: “Health System and Reform in Lebanon” (2003), “Health Beyond Politics” (2009).

Professor Ammar is the recipient of the WHO Shousha Foundation Prize (2016). He is Officer in both the French National Order of Merit and the Belgium’s National Order of the Crown.
