### Painting by SHAFIC ABBOUD "Fenêtre" 1974

**"The window"** is a recurring motif in Abboud's work. The mixed-media technique underscores Abboud's desire to engage texture and light in a visual dialogue, imbuing the painted surface with emotional and sensory depth. As in much of his work, the composition suggests a mental landscape — one inspired by the poetry of a Lebanese childhood, reimagined through the lens of modern European aesthetics.

#### **About the Artist**

Shafic Abboud was born in Lebanon in 1926 and passed away in Paris in 2004. He was one of the most prominent Lebanese painters of the 20th century.

Shafic Abboud moved to Paris in 1947, where he studied in the studios of André Lhote and Fernand Léger. Influenced by the modernist movements sweeping across Europe at the time, he developed a vibrant abstract style that blended memories of his childhood, Byzantine iconography, and oral storytelling. Throughout his career, Abboud exhibited widely across the globe and received numerous awards, including the Victor Choquet Prize in 1961 and the Sursock Museum Prize in 1964. His prolific body of work spans painting, ceramics, lithography, and artist's books.

Yvette Achkar was a Brazilianborn Lebanese abstract painter and art teacher. After moving to Beirut as a child, she studied at ALBA and became a

key figure in Lebanon's modern art movement. Initially drawn to music, she turned to painting and gained early success with her 1960 solo exhibition. Her work evolved into abstraction, marked by emotional expression, rhythm, and color. Achkar also taught for decades, influencing many Lebanese artists. She exhibited widely in Lebanon and internationally, earning recognition and awards.

The chair has made its way into becoming the traditional Lebanese seating. Today, the *Khayzaran* chair making is a comeback with a trendier aspect. Through the use of new materials and techniques, it gains a new meaning, combining the past and the present.




#### **About the Artist**

Samer Alameen's work is anchored in a world of storytelling, something that stems from his extensive background in advertising

Since his studio launch, Alameen's work has been featured in solo and collective exhibitions in Milan, Paris, London, Basel, Dubai, Geneva and Beirut.

The vibrant colors of the onyx, reminiscent of a sunset's hues, infuse warmth into the space further enhancing this piece's allure.
