Berri calls for Lebanese unity amid regional unrest

BEIRUT: Speaker Nabih Berri said
Thursday the turbulent region
required that Lebanon boost its unity,
civil peace and lay down a strategy for
sustainable development. "Amid this
turbulent and tense state of the region
... Lebanon is always in need of
strengthening the factors of its internal
unity, enhancing its civil peace and
agreeing on a strategic plan for sustainable development," Berri said during a ceremony to inaugurate the Faculty of Languages at Universite Saint
Joseph which took place under his
patronage. Berri added that such a
plan should ensure continuity in public administrations. He welcomed the
September visit of Pope Benedict XVI
to Lebanon, saying it would make the
Levant once again a space for partnership. The speaker stressed that democracy, freedom and good governance
should be "a national production
first." – The Daily Star
